1. You must be a UK taxpayer and expect to pay at least as much Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax as The PSP Association will reclaim on your donation(s) in the tax year (e.g. 6th April 2010-5th April 2011).
2. If your circumstances change and you no longer pay Income or Capital Gains Tax to cover the amount claimed by the charity, you can cancel your declaration.
3. If you pay tax at the higher rate, you can claim further tax relief in your Self-Assessment Tax Return.
4. If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief, please contact your local Tax Office for further information.
5. Please notify the charity if you change your name or address.

¹ The PSP Association can claim Gift Aid tax relief of 25p on every pound you give. HMRC will also be operating transitional provisions for Gift Aid donations made from 6 April 2008 until 5 April 2011, paying a Government supplement of 3p on every pound you give.
